	Scheduled 1 completed if the license application pertains to one or more cats, or Schedule 2 if the license application pertains to one or more dogs. Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 must be filled out according to the number of pets (e.g., 2 dogs = One Schedule 2 filled out for dog #1 and one Schedule 2 filled out for dog #2). Every question must be answered in order for the application to be processed.
	A photocopy of a valid photo ID and proof of address. See the list of accepted documents at montreal.ca.
	A cheque made out to Ville de Montréal. The amount to be indicated is the total of boxes selected on the previous page (1). If the application is made after the permit has expired, an additional fee of \$11.00 per permit applies and must be added to the total payment amount.
	Proof of sterilization for each animal.
	Proof of microchipping for each animal.

	A written notice from a veterinarian stating that sterilization is not medically appropriate for the pet.
	A written notice from a veterinarian stating that microchipping is not medically appropriate for the pet.
