Checklist

1. Supplier number

In order to receive financial support from the City of Montréal and from the Conseil des arts de Montréal, you must be registered with the City's registry of suppliers, and obtain a supplier number; as well, your supplier number must be active.

You must register online (in french only): <http://ville.montreal.qc.ca/fournisseur>

Registration for electronic payment is possible (replacing the sending of a cheque by mail). The form is available on the following page (in french only): <https://servicesenligne.ville.montreal.qc.ca/sel/formxml/show/fournisseurs> and is to be returned to pratiques_daffaires@ville.montreal.qc.ca

2. Proof of professional artist status

If you are a member of the Regroupement des artistes en arts visuels du Québec (RAAV) :
digital copy of your RAAV membership card

If you are a member of the Conseil des métiers d'art du Québec (CMAQ):
copy of your CMAQ membership card

If you are not a member of either organization:
attach your artist's CV as well as five photographs of your work

3. Proof of occupancy of the studio

If you are tenant, then you must include:

A digital copy of the initial lease (this is mandatory for each application)

A digital copy of the renewal of the lease (if applicable) for the year 2021 (January 1 to December 31, 2021) of the artist's studio

If you are an owner, you must include:

A digital copy of your 2021 municipal tax bill

Proof of the dimensions of your studio (using a certificate of occupancy or other document)

4. Proof of storage occupancy (if applicable)

If the storage space is located at a different address from the studio:

Attach a digital copy version of the storage space lease
