

The major work to replace the outdated underground infrastructures, which is more than a century old, will now extend to Rue Peel, on both sides of Rue Saint-Catherine Ouest.

Traffic hindrances and delivery zones from March 18

- Rue Peel from March 18:
- Between the alley behind H&M and Boulevard René-Lévesque : local traffic only
- Between Place Mount-Royal and the alley behind H&M: complete closure
- Between Boulevard De Maisonneuve and Place Mount-Royal : local traffic only
- Rue du Square-Dorchester, between Rue Metcalfe and Rue Peel : local traffic only (except for the western section, which is complety blocked).

Current traffic hindrances and delivery zones

- Rue Sainte-Catherine O:
 - o Between Rue Stanley and Rue Mansfield: complete closure
 - o Between Rue Drummond and Rue Stanley: local delivery traffic only
- Rue Metcalfe :
 - o Between Place Mont-Royal and Rue du Square-Dorchester : complete closure
 - o North of Boulevard De Maisonneuve O: partial obstruction on the eastbound lane
 - o Between Boulevard De Maisonneuve O and Place Mount-Royal : local traffic only
 - o Between Boulevard René-Lévesque O and Rue du Square-Dorchester : local traffic only
- Mansfield/Metcalfe alley (located between Rue Sainte-Catherine O and Boulevard René-Lévesque O): complete closure
- Place Mount-Royal, between Rue Metcalfe and Rue Peel: local traffic only

TO KNOW

Garbage and recyclable

- Garbage and recyclable collection according to the usual schedule.
- Impacted sector: On collection days, place your garbage cans and bins, well-identified with your address, at the usual place. Containers that are not accessible to the garbage collectors will be moved by the contractor.

Noise, dust and vibration

- The use of tools and other equipment may cause odors, dust, noise and vibrations.
- A special attention will be paid to work organization so that the noisiest and most disruptive operations be carried out at the most opportune time, to cause as little disturbance as possible to the population.

Work schedule

- Regular schedule: Monday to Saturday between 6 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- Works are authorized 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.
- The extended schedule will be used to minimize the impact of daytime operations. For example, buildings water service
 connections (water and sewer) will be replaced at night. Work in front of building entrances will be carried out outside
 peak hours.
