Important to know

Parking

Restrictions in place
starting the week of March 7

- Parking spaces used to install a construction trailer on the west side of Avenue Brooke. A space for persons with reduced mobility will be maintained.
- Alternative parking spaces are planned for City of Westmount red permit holders on the east side of Avenue Greene. Refer to the signage for details.

Traffic

- **Starting in mid-March:** obstruction on the south side of Rue Saint-Antoine. Only one westbound lane will be open between Atwater and Rue Bourget. Closure of the Brewster intersection.
- **March 19 and 20:** weekend closure of the south side of the intersection of Rue Bel-Air, which will end in a cul-de-sac.
- **March 26 and 27:** weekend closure of the south side of the intersection of Rose-de-Lima.
- **Starting March 28:** closure of the south side of the intersection of Avenue Greene.

Temporary interruption of the water supply

- Those affected will receive a door hanger 48 hours in advance.

Access to buildings

- Residences, businesses and other establishments will be accessible. Walkways will be set up to allow access to buildings at all times.

Public transit

- Service will be maintained, but bus stop locations, schedules and routes may change. Information: STM-INFO (514-786-4636) or www.stm.info/en.

Garbage, recyclables and compost

- The collection schedules will be maintained. Garbage cans and bins that are not accessible to the collectors will be moved by the company performing the work. Each container must be clearly identified with your address so that it can be returned to the right place.
